'Project of Excellence Award - Pride in everything we do'


- Recognition will also be given to any projects that stand out from the other submissions for their outstanding efforts around innovation and initiatives driven with their project team, or specifically relating to the strategy
- The awards will be funded through the allowable cost claimed against the project budget
